# **Approval of Draft Meeting Minutes May 2, 2023:**

## 1) Canada Soccer Club Licensing-New Policies Drafted (3 attached)

# 2) 2024 EOSL/OCSL Summer Season Summary

**HL**-, only 2 complaints, one on field on conditions and referee with one team, balancing of the teams at U10 HL and it was due to friend requests, some of the issues that contributed to unbalanced teams were also related to players just stop coming.

Discussed the importance of the pre-season coaches meeting, issues with timing with EDOSA meeting.

**OCSL** – OT Men's league my go to OT4 next year, MC3 may get promoted, Women's not as successful as previous years, no outstanding discipline, optional AR rescheduled games need to notify the RIC to assign.

**EDOSA** – one team finished 1<sup>st</sup>; medal/trophies will be delivered to the club for the team.

**DEV** – one boys team moved to Tier 1 up mid-season, another team to move up to Tier 1 next season, still DEV and not COMP league.

**2 Red Cards** – carry over until next year U18 and U16 players, players will be both U18 next season.

Hearing against Club/Coach infraction still on-going with Ontario Soccer, fine was reduced and returned, some additional fines for missing jersey numbers, game sheet signatures, as

examples. KDSC \$1.11 per game season, Ontario Soccer registration per player is increasing next year.

### 3) 2024/2025 Fall/Winter Program Planning

Approval on school booking, Saturday/Sunday mornings were already booked – 1-6pm starting Oct 27 – Dec 15, 8 weeks U8, U10, U12, U18 - \$55 per session.

U11 is looking for a league to play in, cannot play at Coliseum but the club must have an indoor facility to play on, EOSL requirement, Jeff will send the coach an email about the Futsal league in Ottawa.

EDOSA club participation in unsanctioned winter league, only allowed to participate league as players and not teams. Can not include any connection with the club, including uniforms.
